Title IX, VAWA & The Clery Act

Understanding Your School's Obligations

Title IX requires schools that receive complaints of sexual misconduct to investigate such complaints and to take immediate action to eliminate misconduct, prevent its recurrence, and address its effects. The Clery Act, as amended by the re-authorization of the Violence Against Women Act, requires that any institutional disciplinary hearings involving sexual misconduct be conducted by officials who receive annual training on the issues related to domestic violence, dating violence, sexual assault, and stalking and how to conduct an investigation and hearing process that protects the safety of victims and promotes accountability.

This training session will educate school officials on issues of sexual misconduct, their obligations to take corrective action when issues arise at their schools, and what procedures to follow when sexual misconduct occurs.

All participants who complete the training session will receive a certificate of completion to document their participation.

This training meets the annual VAWA training requirement required by the U.S. Department of Education of all Title-IV approved institutions.
