Title IX, VAWA & the Clery Act

Understanding Your School's Obligations

The Violence Against Women Act (VAWA) requires schools to develop programs in an effort to prevent incidents of sexual misconduct from occurring, and to have policies and procedures in place to investigate and adjudicate allegations of sexual misconduct on their campuses. One of VAWA's key elements is that any disciplinary proceedings involving cases of sexual misconduct must be conducted by school officials who receive annual training on issues of sexual misconduct.

Attorney Chris DeLuca, the founder of DeLuca Law LLC, will offer a special training program for school owners and administrators on the issues of sexual misconduct, and how to investigate and conduct a hearing process that protects the safety of victims and promotes accountability. This training program will address many topics required by VAWA, including:

- *Identifying and reporting domestic violence, dating violence, sexual assault and Stalking*
- *Explaining the victims' rights in all processes and procedures*
- *Investigating, responding to and rendering findings on complaints*
